## 2007 Poetry Contest for a FIRST BOOK

**Final Judge: Evie Shockley**  
**Prize: Publication, \$1000, and 10 copies**  
**Entry Deadline: December 1, 2006**

### Guidelines:

- Send **2 copies** of a 48- to 64-page poetry manuscript. Page count must include title page, table of contents and optional dedication page.
- Ms. should be typed, single-spaced, and bound with spring clip or paperclip.
- **4 copies** of the title page, which should include title of ms. only, **no author's name**.
- Table of contents should also include title of ms.
- Include full contact information, title of manuscript, brief bio and acknowledgments of previous publications on one cover sheet or letter.
- Enclose a check written to Carolina Wren Press for \$18.
- Enclose #10 SASE for contest results. (No mss. will be returned.)
- Individual poems may have been published in literary journals or as a chapbook, but not the ms. as a whole. Manuscripts that have been self-published previously are not eligible.
- Contest is open only to poets who have **NOT** published a full-length collection of poetry (that is, a collection of 48 pages or more).
- Simultaneous submissions are fine; please let us know if, during our judging period, your ms. is accepted elsewhere.
